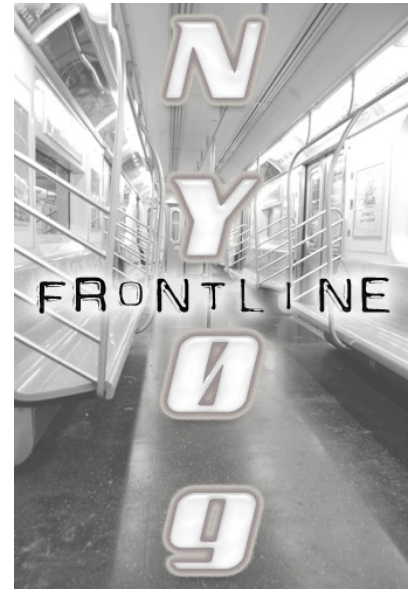

Once teams are set, we will be counting on the participation of each member in every facet of preparation from fundraising to prayer. Before signing up for this trip, please carefully pray about where God is leading you. While certain circumstances may come that will prevent a participant from participating, money raised will not be refunded. Instead it will be applied to others going on this trip. With rare exception, participants spots that are vacated will not be filled with someone who has decided they want to go. This is due to the necessary preparation that must take place. Therefore any decision to leave Frontline:NY09 must be made with great amounts of prayer and counsel. All participants must raise the entire amount of their trip in order to participate in Frontline:NY09

Guidelines of conduct will be given to each individual in their respective teams as life in NYC is much different than in Burlington, NC. On these trips, respect for those in leadership with Frontline:NY09 and of the YWAM staff is non-negotiable. These individuals are responsible for your lives and must be shown appropriate respect. Failure to do so will endanger the safety of not only the individual but the entire team and possibly put our hosts at risk as well. Such conduct may result in the dismissal of the participant from the trip and necessitate an early trip home. Participants under the age of 18 returning early will require an adult escort. The participant and their family will be liable for all costs incurred due to behavioral issues.

We fully anticipate another great year and look forward to see how God is planning to use you this year.
